On Saturday, Feb. 27th, A Fischer Random chess tournament will be held at Gere library, 2400 S. 56th Street. There will be five rounds at 10:00am, 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, and 2:00pm. The time controls will be Game/15. This means each player will have 15 minutes to finish their game. If a game reaches the 20 minute mark, a clock may be placed on the game at the discretion of the tournament director. Please register for one of four sections, K-2, K-5, K-8, or Open. What is Fischer Random Chess? It's a new challenge!

Fischer Random Chess , also called Chess/960 is a way to play chess with the same rules, except that the major and minor pieces start on different squares than in a regular game. The pawns start on their normal 2nd and 7th ranks. It is fun and challenging and not too difficult, even for younger children. Each round of the tournament will be from a different alignment of the pieces to be presented to the players by the tournament director so that all players start from the same selected position. **Try it, you'll like it!**
