Applications for library cards may be made at any Lincoln City Libraries location. An initial library card is free to Lincoln and Lancaster County residents and to individuals residing outside Lancaster County who pay Lancaster County property taxes. Lost cards can be replaced for \$1.

The Bookmobile visits regular stops every two weeks. Holiday closings are listed at the bottom of the schedule. In case of stop cancellation due to weather or mechanical difficulties, due dates will be adjusted.

Requests for items not currently on the Bookmobile can be made by placing holds through the library's online catalog or at <http://www.lincolnlibraries.org>, by calling any library location, or by submitting titles to Bookmobile staff. Please allow several days for items to reach the Bookmobile when placing holds online or by phone.

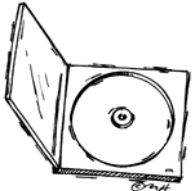
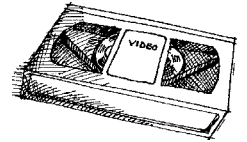
