

Classroom Loan Bags

Lincoln City Libraries classroom loan bags each contain approximately 15-25 copies of the same title. Available bags are updated each year to reflect the current Golden Sower nominees. As with any book, we recommend that teachers read the book before they use it in their classroom to determine if it is appropriate for their needs, though we do note the published recommended age range following every title. All public, private, and home school teachers with a Lincoln City Libraries card are welcome to use these bags. After-school care professionals and early childhood educators are welcome to use these bags as well.

The following guidelines apply to the use of these bags:

- Bags must be picked up and dropped off at Bennett Martin Public Library (136 S. 14th St.) during regular business hours. They can't be left in a book drop.
 - Hours are:
 - Monday through Thursday: 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Friday & Saturday: 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
 - Sunday: Noon to 6 p.m.
- Reservations go by calendar month instead of regular due dates. Each user can reserve up to two bags for a given calendar month and can reserve each bag for one or two calendar months in a row, as available. - Bags may be picked up on the 1st of the reserved month, and are due back on the 26th of that month, or the next month.
- There are no late fees or fees for a reasonable amount of copies lost in the process of loaning them out to students.
